The BT DI team will be competing in the East Metro Regional Tournament on Saturday, March 4, at 1:40. The tournament is at Harding High School, and is free and open to the public. The team also competes in an "Instant Challenge" in the morning.

Destination ImagiNation is an international creative problem-solving competition. Teams of up to 7 students chose a challenge, work on a creative solution for several months, and then present their solution at a regional tournament. Teams may advance to state and global tournaments.

This year's team, which operates as a 2nd trimester enhancement class, has chosen the "Show & Tech" challenge, which requires the team to create a stage which can move a team member from one location to another, as well as to create two acts, each with its own special "tech effect." This year's team is "Diamond Dime." Team members are 8th graders Rosita ML & Liliana R, and 7th graders Joseph B, Nate S, Esteban V, Rudy VZ, and Faraes W. The team manager is Mrs. Myott. 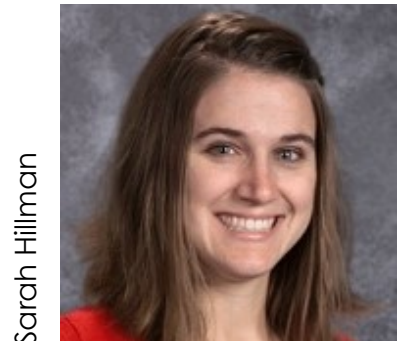

Ham Bingo — April 1st

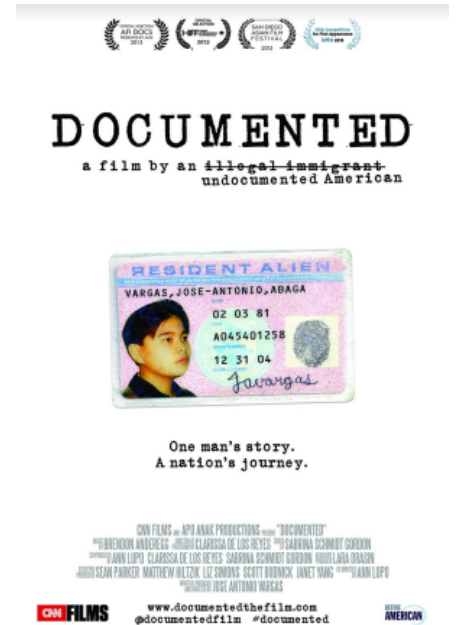
