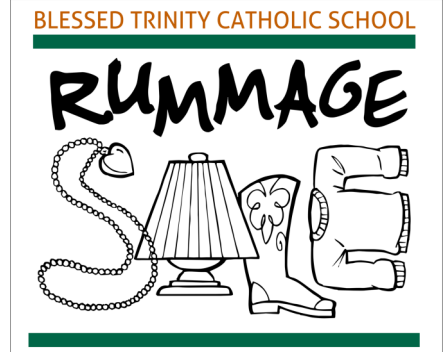
Fr. Jerry's Paschal Mystery Exhibit
