## FRIEND OF BLESSED TRINITY AWARD

The Friend of Blessed Trinity award is given to members of our community who selflessly give of themselves in support of our school. We are blessed to be able to call on the time, talents and treasures of so many volunteers. These volunteers and friends are current and alumni parents as well as parishioners of our supporting parishes and others in our deanery. This year we are excited to award Nancy Cullen and Paul Peichel as recipients of the Friend of Blessed Trinity award.

Nancy has been part of our Blessed Trinity community for more than 14 years, sending all three of her children, David '13, Katie '15 and Matthew '18, through our school.

Through her years of service for Blessed Trinity, Nancy has led and supported many aspects of our community including chairing the Sno\*Ball committee, devoting countless hours and effort to the Grand Gala committee and serving in a leadership role as a school board member and chair, not to mention the countless everyday things BT parents do without even thinking about it.



Paul's service to our school community continues through today though his youngest son Caleb graduated in 2014. Both of Paul's sons, Caleb '14, and John '09, attended Blessed Trinity since they were in preschool. Paul is a constant presence in our first grade classroom as a Royal Reader. For the last 11 years he has walked into first grade on a weekly basis to introduce children to new books and some of his favorites like "Pickle Chiffon Pie." Students know him as "Mr. Book Man" – his reputation precedes him.
