Medical exemption:  No child is required to receive an immunization if they have a medical contraindication, history of disease, or laboratory evidence of immunity. For a child to receive a medical exemption, a physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant must sign this statement:  I certify the immunization(s) listed below are contraindicated for medical reasons, laboratory evidence of immunity, or that adequate immunity exists due to a history of disease that was laboratory confirmed (for varicella disease see * below). List exempted immunization(s):</li> <li>B. Conscientious exemption:  No child is required to have an immunization that is trary to the conscientiously held beliefs of his/her paragraphic or guardian.
